## GRID REFERENCE



A 1:10 000 grid reference takes the form of 341000 402500, made up of the easting (the distance of a point east of the origin of the Irish Grid) and the northing (distance of a point north of the origin).

The distance between each grid line on the map represents 500m (the last 3 digits on the 6 figure easting or northing) so an estimate of the grid reference of any point on the map is possible.
