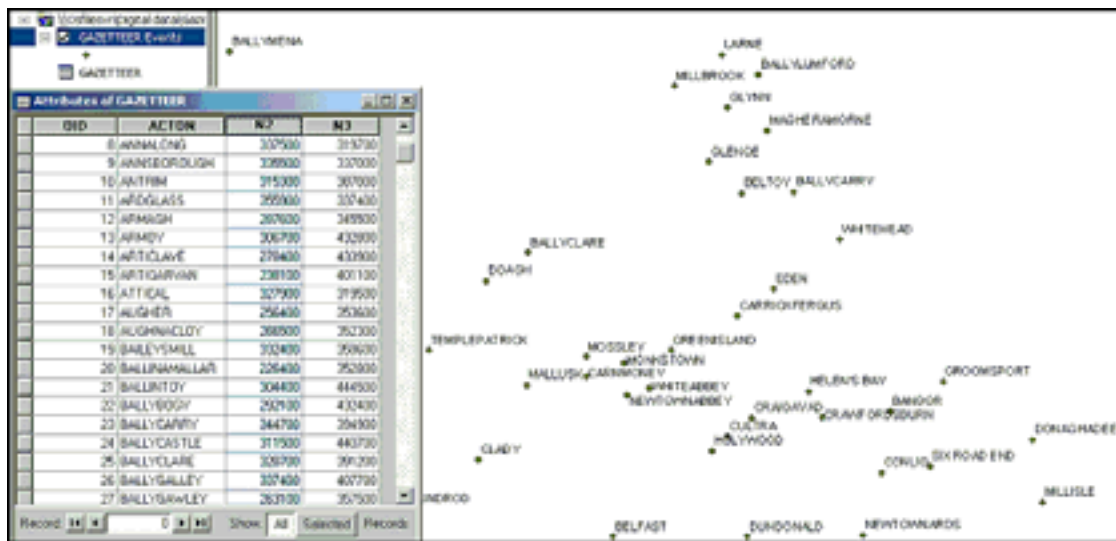


## What is OSNI Place Name Gazetteer?

The OSNI Place Name Gazetteer contains a list of the main cities, town and villages of Northern Ireland complete with Irish Grid references accurate to 100m. Using a GI system with suitable software, places can be identified and listed within defined geographical areas.



## Technical Features & Benefits

- ◆ Derived from OSNI's 1:250 000 scale mapping, providing complete coverage of Northern Ireland
- ◆ Each place name contains Irish Grid co-ordinates
- ◆ Compatible with other OSNI products and can be overlaid with raster or vector data
- ◆ Can be displayed on virtually any Geographical Information System or database software package
- ◆ Users can add their own information to points
- ◆ Labels can be positioned automatically and users can set font and point size
