

## What is OSNI SABE?

OSNI SABE forms part of the SABE dataset, which has been compiled from data supplied by 35 National Mapping and Cadastral Agencies (NMCAs) in Europe, all members of EuroGeographics. It contains all administrative units for LGD and Ward. As it is a seamless database, there are no gaps or overlaps between polygons derived from different sources.

## Technical Features & Benefits

- ◆ SABE covers 35 Countries in Europe and is delivered as individual Country files which can be joined to create a seamless and consistent database. OSNI SABE covers Northern Ireland
- ◆ Contains all levels of national administrative hierarchies from the highest (Country) to the lowest and includes names and codes of administrative units (Ward) based on the national classifications
- ◆ SABE has a unified coding system for all administrative levels and includes names of the levels and the relationship between them
- ◆ Includes coastline information
- ◆ Is available at two geometric resolutions: 30 metres at 1:250 000 scale and 200 metres at 1:1 000 000 scale. Both products contain the same attributes
